## **The Patrick J. Maloney Memorial Bursary**

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### **Patrick J. Maloney**

Pat Maloney (1930-2019) was born in Kemptville and raised his family here. He spent most of his adult life involved in local community activities: Holy Cross Parish, Lions Club, Kemptville Town Council and its various service committees, and the local council of the Knights of Columbus. Pat's musical talent enriched many community functions and family activities. He is survived by his wife Anita and daughters Colleen, Sara and Kerry and their families. May he rest in peace.

### **Application Requirements**

Candidates for this bursary, which is designed to assist a graduating student entering the first year of post-secondary education, must have applied for admission into a full-time program at a University or College. Academic success as well as service to church, school, and community will be considered. Children or grandchildren of members in good standing with the Knights of Columbus will be given special consideration, as will students associated with Holy Cross Parish. The final date for filing will be Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

An application will be deemed to be incomplete unless completed in full and includes:

- An autobiographical statement containing a description of the applicant's educational objectives and his/her involvement in parish, community, and school. One (1) typed page maximum.
- A letter of recommendation from a person of the candidate's choice.
- An official transcript of secondary school grades including, if applicable, mid-term marks of the second semester of the final year.
- A completed Application Form.

### **Conditions of the Patrick J. Maloney Bursary**

The successful candidate will be notified by phone or mail by the end of May. Regrettably, other applicants will not be contacted. The bursary amount for 2022 is \$1000.00 (CAD). Materials submitted in support of the application will not be returned. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Assignment of this bursary is fully at the discretion of the Bursary Committee of the Knights of Columbus, Holy Cross Council 5333. Their decision shall be final.

If circumstances permit, the bursary will be presented to the successful candidate at his/her graduation ceremony. If this is not possible, then either a personal presentation will be made or the cheque shall be forwarded to the successful applicant. The successful applicant thereby permits his or her name and photo to be used in Knights of Columbus material supporting the bursary program.
