## De-streamed -

Students who find success within a larger class and can complete tasks in a directed environment or independently may choose the de-streamed program.

## Essentials -

Essential courses focus on the fundamental concepts of the discipline while using real-world applications and hands-on experiences.

Students who find success with extra assistance and smaller class sizes may choose the essentials program. Students who have not been working at grade level in a particular subject area should consider essentials.

After successfully completing this course, students will choose essentials grade 10. There will be an option to complete grade 9 de-streamed courses if the student wants to change levels.
